County Spotlight:

<u>Strengthening Preparedness Through Partnership: Greenwood LEPC Table-Top Exercise at EA Sween</u> Company

On June 17, 2025, members of the Greenwood County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), emergency responders, and private industry partners gathered at EA Sween Company's manufacturing facility located at 5730 Hwy 25 in Hodges, SC, to conduct a comprehensive tabletop exercise. The scenario used was an ammonia leak at the loading dock during transfer of product. The incident required a coordinated local response involving fire service, law enforcement, EMS, and emergency management officials. The simulation prompted an evacuation of the plant and collaboration with the local responders to secure and clear the scene. The event highlighted the importance of the LEPC which brought together the private sector and first responders.
